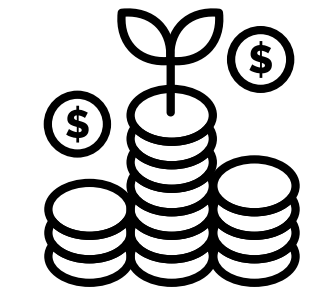


STUDENT ATTITUDE SURVEY

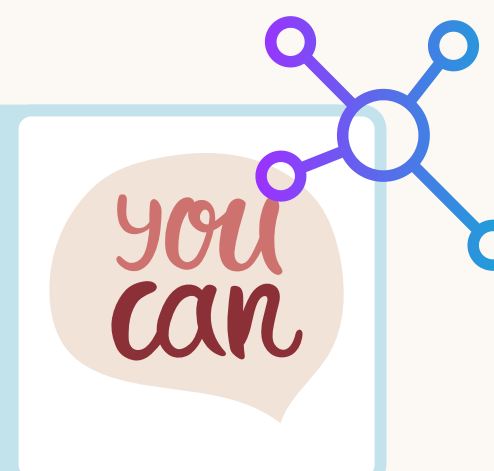

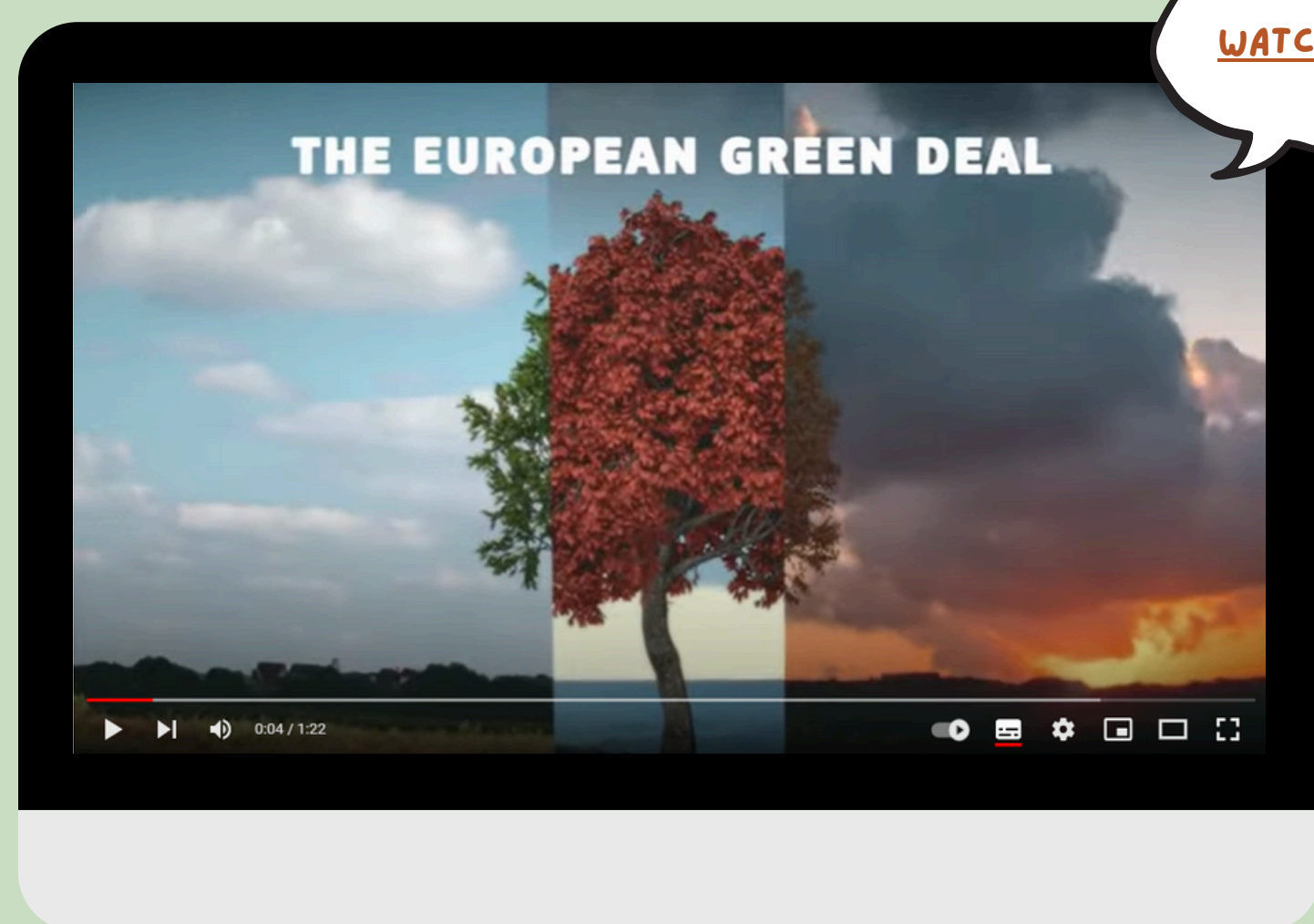
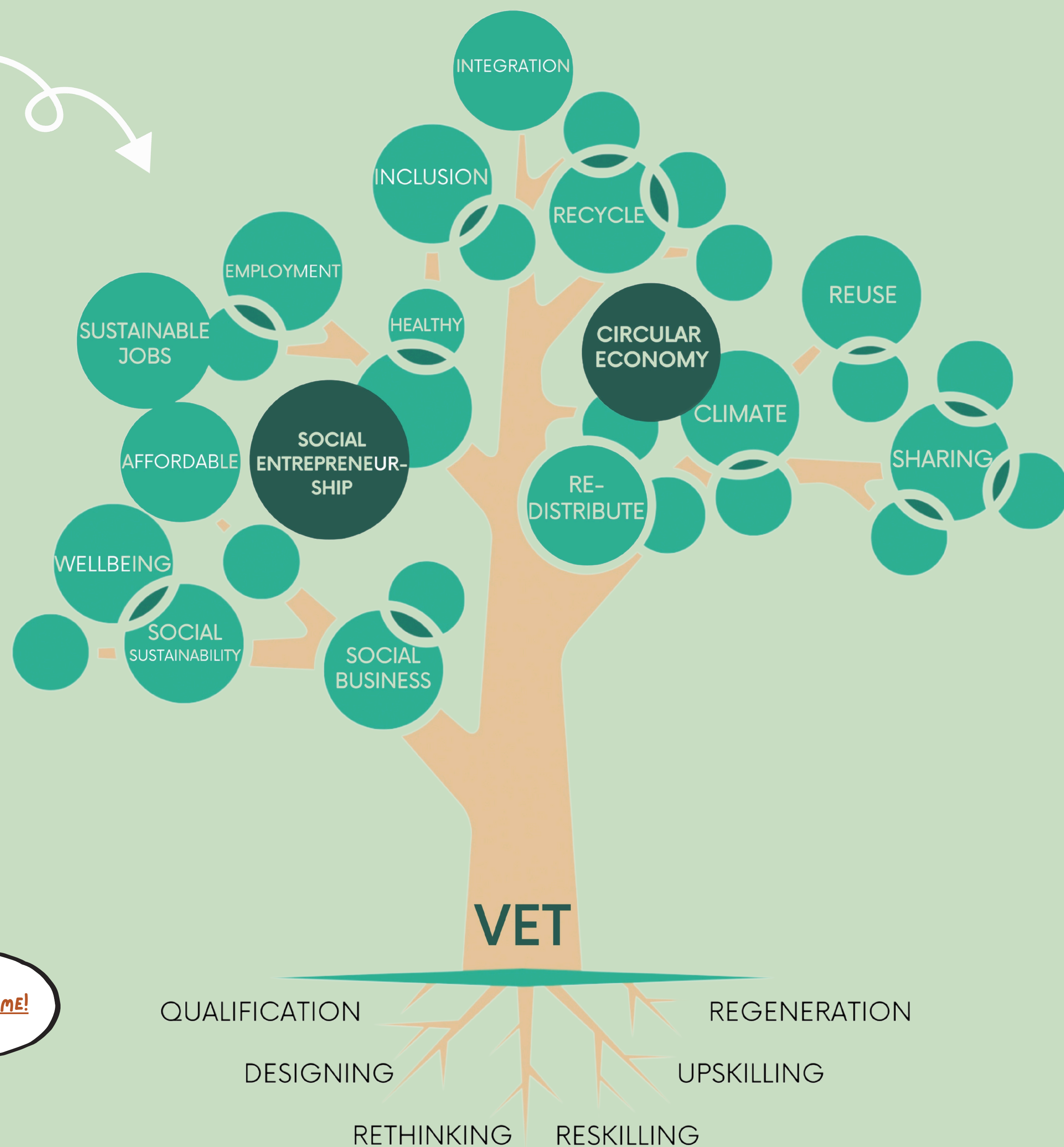


ANCHORING SOCIAL CIRCULAR ECONOMY ATTITUDES IN VET
