

### Social circular economy?


Overall, there seems to be some uncertainty about what this concept exactly entails.



22,6% indicates that they either "More or less understand", 18,7% indicates to "understand" Social Circular problems and solutions from different disciplines

Majority answers between more or less agree to completely agree



### Participating in a circular economy would make me satisfied.

The majority of respondents agree (54%) or completely agree (32%) that participating in a circular economy would make them satisfied.

40% indicates that there may be




some uncertainty or lack of knowledge about the potential impact of green jobs on the economy.
